Blighted Properties

Murdick Angelina Property (Eagles Bldg.)

Brad Sparks informed the board that more than likely the state fire marshal was going to force the building down. He also stated that he felt it was probably going to fall in the lap of the city. Mayor Wilkes stated that he wanted to wait and see where the state goes with it.

Bowman Property

The Bowman's started to take down the home but did not clean the property up. Steve and Janet Wade, neighbors of the property were present to voice their concerns. Brad Sparks let the Wades know that Ricky Bowman and his wife had until Monday November 13th to get the property cleaned up otherwise Carr-Thomas would be in there within two days of the 13th to get in cleaned up.

Motion was made by George Skill to give the Bowman's until November 13th to get the property cleaned up and for Carr-Thomas to get it cleaned up if the Bowmans do not comply, 2nd by Tony Richards. 3 ayes, passed.
