1. Sidewalk and ADA ramp construction: NE 2nd Street from D street to H street; NE 3rd Street from D street to H street. (Completed)
2. ADA access to Carnegie Heritage Arts Center. (Completed)
3. Aquatic lift for city pool. (Completed)
4. Sidewalk repair and ADA ramps on Main Street from B street to D street; B street from 2nd street NW to 3rd street NE.
5. ADA accessible City Hall Entrance and Bathroom. (Completed)
6. All new ADA ramps and walkway at City Hall.
7. Playground and splash park on west side of city park. (Completed)
8. ADA restroom in west shelter house at City Park. (Completed)
9. ADA parking downtown. (Completed)
10. Sidewalk on 2nd ST NE from D ST to Hwy 54.
11. Sidewalk on 3rd ST NE from D ST to Hwy 54.
12. ADA Parking and Railing installed at Linton Police Department(Completed)
13. ADA Restroom in east shelter house at City Park (Completed)
