NEW BUSINESS

Resolution #2021-11 Surplus Bond Proceeds

Clerk-Treasurer Wright explained that the Sewage Works Revenue Bond from 2018 had unused bond proceeds sitting in a construction fund. The funds could not be used to pay back toward the bond. Wright explained the proposed resolution broadened the language on the uses of the funds. The uses are listed as exhibit A in the resolution. A motion was made by Tony Richards to approve the resolution, 2nd by Linda Bedwell. 5 ayes, passed.

Resolution #2021-12 Linton Redevelopment Commission

A motion was made by Linda Bedwell to approving an order of the common council of the City of Linton, determining that a declaratory resolution and redevelopment plan approved and adopted by the Linton Redevelopment Commission conform to the comprehensive plan and approving that resolution and the redevelopment plan, 2nd by Jerry Ellett. 5 ayes, passed.

A motion to approve Resolution 2021-12 (a resolution approving the resolution approved by the Linton Redevelopment Commission which removed parcels from the City of Linton Development Commission allocation area and approving the order of the Linton City Council) by Linda Bedwell, 2nd by Les Newman. 5 ayes, passed.

Resolution #2021-13 Appropriating ARPA Fund

A motion to approve \$384,000 of the American Rescue Plan Act Funds for improvements at the city's Wastewater Treatment Plant (federal mandated phosphorus removal process) by Linda Bedwell, 2nd by Tony Richards. 5 ayes, passed.

Resolution #2021-14 Cozy Corner


