
**NEW BUSINESS**  
**2022 Budget Line Item**

Mayor Wilkes opened the discussion on the Cemetery Superintendent budget line item with a brief explanation on why he felt that position deserved more than the normal three percent raise. Tony Richards added that at the previous meeting he had made a motion to give that position roughly a four percent raise. He went on to explain that after listening to Operations Manager Brent Murray (direct supervisor over the Cemetery Superintendents) at the last meeting explained that the county was giving their employees roughly a six percent increase. Richards made a motion to amend the amount passed at the October 12<sup>th</sup> meeting (\$33,300) to \$34,000 in Ordinance 2021-08, which would give that position a roughly six percent raise, 2<sup>nd</sup> made by Les Newman. 3 ayes, passed. (Jeff Sparks abstained from the vote due to his conflict of interest) Mayor Wilkes formally agreed to pull his veto of that line item.
