Wooldridge Construction Group. 4 ayes, passed. Wooldridge Construction Group was the only bid submitted for the demolition of the property.

New Police Cars

Police Chief Paul Clark stated he will need an additional appropriation for \$64,566.06. This includes funds that were not used from 2021 that were returned.

ARPA Funds

Brent Slover stated the treatment plant has 4 pumps that was all built new in 2014. Started maintenance and software updates last year, however 4 new pumps are needed. Would like to use the \$102,600 ARPA Funds as they qualify. Motion was made by Linda Bedwell, 2nd by Leslie Newman. 4 ayes, motion passed.


No Reports
